Dear Member:

You are one of the owners of our Fishing Pier. What would you do to repair the damage left by the September hurricane—have it rebuilt as speedily as possible? That is just what your Committee is striving to do. A competent engineer has drawn up plans for its rebuilding. These plans and blue prints are now on display at the Club House. We propose to extend the new pier one hundred (100) feet further seaward. For deeper water, low tide fishing, less sea grass and therefore, BETTER FISHING. The entire cost will be approximately

\$25,000.00

This is one responsibility we all share in common — the financing of this project. It is more than a few men can do alone.

We have had fifteen members come unsolicited and agree to loan more than 25% of the amount of its financing — \$7,500.00. We want all members to take part in this as it is your property. We are not asking for any specific amount. Let each member assist as he feels able.

We are herewith enclosing a facsimile note to be issued to all subscribers to the Pier Rebuilding Fund.

Won't you fill out the facsimile note and mail with your check to Frank J. Jacobs, 110 North Avolyn Avenue, Ventnor City, N. J., Chairman of the Rebuilding Committee. It will be impossible for us to give out this contract unless we have sufficient money on hand to warrant this indebtedness.

Don't delay, as material and labor are scarce. Every minute counts. We want to have the Pier completed in time for the 1945 season.

If the Pier is not rebuilt, money will be returned to all subscribers. If over-subscribed, a greater percentage will be repaid.
