Anglers Club Plans Weekly Contests

Weekly fishing contests restricted to members and guests of the Anglers' Club of Absecon Island are to be inaugurated early in August, according to H. W. Shaner, secretary of the organization. Prizes will be given for fish caught from the club's pier in Margate.

In addition, gold, silver and bronze awards will be made for catches of striped bass, channel bass, weakfish and bluefish. These may be caught from Sandy Hook to Cape May.

Mr. Shaner stated that fishing has been good lately. Sea water temperatures running from four to five degrees above normal have attracted the fish inshore.

Striped bass are now in the surf, and other fish are expected to be plentiful soon. On June 12, according to the club's records, a splendid catch of 322 fish was made. Frank Jacobs got the first croaker of the season and T. Irwins hooked the first weakfish on June 5.

J. Roberts recorded a day's catch of 31 fish from the pier while S. W. Ford caught a 3 1-4 lb. weak.
