Charles Schreiner Lands nine Kingfish to Annex Honors at Atlantic City

Atlantic City, July 14.—Catching nine kingfish, Charles Schreiner, of 1215 N. 20th st., Philadelphia, won top honors in the Absecon Island Anglers Club weekly tournament held here yesterday. At the Atlantic City Club pier, Joe Simon, 511 Dudley st., was second while Dr. L. E. Halpern, 5401 Lebanon av., was third.

One of the largest throngs ever to fish out of this resort brought back heavy hauls of porgies, weaks, kings, seabass and bonita over the week-end. Several hundred boats, party and private, went out.  
With the water temperature around 70 degrees and weather clear, surf and pier anglers also enjoyed good results (weaks and kings). Bay fishermen likewise fared well, with many catches reported.  
Norris Truckess, 430 Chelton ave., Philadelphia, caught 12 large kings from Absecon Pier, while Arthur Hanft, 148 Somserville ave., Philadelphia, hooked 11 kings and 1 weak. A party from the United Container Co., Philadelphia, took 165 porgies and a few seabass near the wrecks, about 10 miles off shore.
