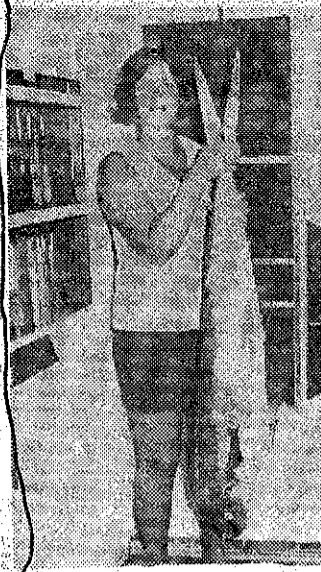

Marlin, Stripers, Dolphin To Latest Press Entries

Action continues lively in the Press Southern New Jersey Fishing Contest. There are still three months to go as anglers in Atlantic, Cape May, Cumberland and Ocean counties go after the \$1,000 in sportsman prizes being offered by this paper.

Heading the latest batch of entries is a 62 pound, 8 ounce white marlin caught by Jasper Freeman Sr., of Meshoppen, Pa., while fishing the Baltimore Canyon aboard the Sea Date captained by Carl Ober. The fish was weighed in at Repp's in Vineland.

Harry Rice of Philadelphia checked in with a 29 3/4 pound striped bass caught in the surf near the Million Dollar Pier. Fred Greenberg of Ventnor entered a 13-8 striper caught in the surf at Longport.

Bill Kunik of Longport entered a 27 pound, 12 ounce dolphin caught southwest of five fathom light ship aboard the Makara captained by Gene Gatter.

Ginny Gottlieb of Margate checked in with a 26 pound dolphin. George Loder of Millville made his bid for a prize with his 5 pound, 2 ounce weakfish caught at Delaware Bay.

Sam Silberman of Margate entered a 3-2 weakie caught off the Anglers Club Pier in Margate. William Merote of Somers Point entered a 2-13 weakie weighed in at Dick's Dock in Somers Point.

Paul Rossi of Palisades Park checked in with a 7-4 flounder caught at Rainbow Channel.

In the Fresh Water Division Mrs. Mellon Houser of Vineland made a bid for a prize with her 5 pound large mouth bass. Wayne Mastas of Linwood checked in with a 4-5 bass, while Frank Burr Jr., of Linwood entered a 3-4 bass.
